Title: Pin well installation

Pin Well Installation

Work is underway for the installation of an additional 10 pin wells at the Walleys Quarry facility. Works will be undertaken and managed by the Landfill Gas Management contractor at the facility, CEL, Cotesbach Energy Limited.

There are 8 pin wells planned for installation along the southern flank of site and 2 additional pin wells to the northwest flank of the facility. During the works 7 pin wells will be installed along the western flank to replace the existing ones, which will be decommissioned. This gives a total of 17 pin wells being installed as part of these works.

A Pin Well is a shallow depth gas extraction well used for environmental control and is complementary to the existing extraction infrastructure at the facility.

The works will be managed in line with the agreed procedures, and it is not anticipated that there will be any offsite impact.
