Do take time to refresh yourself on our latest driver guidance Nothing is more important to us than keeping people safe in and around Walleys Quarry. Please help keep everyone safe by driving responsibly and always respecting our community.

ONLY GET TO AND FROM OUR SITE VIA APPROVED ROUTES

To keep everyone safe there are pre-agreed transport routes in place which our hauliers and contractors must adhere to. Drivers can only access our site via these agreed routes. Please use the A34 and the following roads only:

**CHURCH LANE / LOWER MILEHOUSE LANE · SILVERDALE ROAD
KNUTTON LANE · CEMETERY ROAD · KEELE ROAD**

DO EVERYTHING YOU CAN TO KEEP NOISE AND DISRUPTION TO A MINIMUM

Please be mindful of our neighbours, our site sits alongside both residential and business communities. Take particular care when accessing our site early in the morning and during the weekends.

ALWAYS KEEP ACCESS OPEN AND DRIVE WITH DUE CARE AND ATTENTION

We kindly ask you respect the local community as you drive to and from the site, reduce your speed and do not block access to nearby properties and sites.

DO NOT CAUSE OBSTRUCTIONS

Please don't stop, drive on or park on the pavements and grass that surrounds our site, this includes the cemetery lay-by opposite our entrance.

PARK AT STAFFORDSHIRE WASTE RECYCLING CENTRE IF YOU ARRIVE BEFORE 7AM

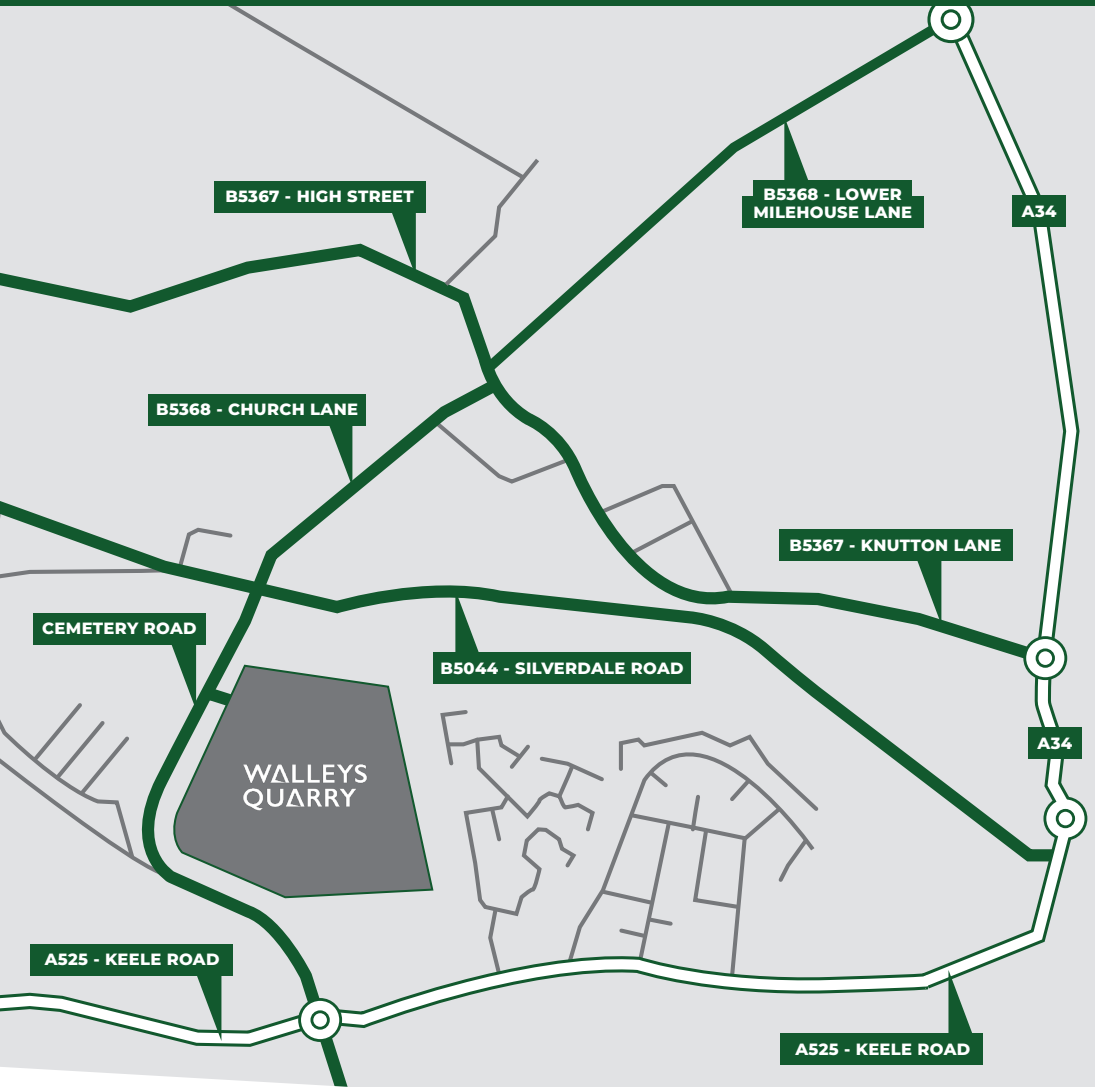
If you arrive before our gates open at 7am, please do not park along Cemetery Road, use the parking facilities at Staffordshire Waste Recycling Centre. This is approximately 5 miles away and you'll need to pay on arrival at the main reception.

USE THE WHEEL WASH BEFORE YOU LEAVE SITE

You must clean your vehicle's wheels using the facilities provided every time you leave Walleys Quarry. This is to minimise mud build up on the surrounding roads, which can cause a real risk, particularly in autumn and winter months.
