PRESS INFORMATION

Welcome to the first of the 2022 Walleys Quarry updates.

Within the permitted and engineered containment system at Walleys Quarry (WQ) the main area of infilling has been focussed on the central and eastern areas of site. These areas are predominantly within Cell 3. Access is gained around the Northern site boundary, comprising a hardcore site road leading into the operational area.

In the run up to the Christmas period, it has become necessary to switch infilling locations to the area adjacent to the western flank. This was due to the difficulties in accessing the area, along the internal site roads due to the inclement weather seen in December. This is a normal process, given the nature of landfill operations within the UK during times of heavy rainfall.

The area adjacent to the western flank sits within the permitted and engineered containment system and, being previously engineered was available to move the infilling operations relocate. The area benefits from closer access to the weighbridge and our transfer operations, situated on the concrete pad within the permitted development. The intention is to continue in this location in Q1 2022.

It is planned to complete the landfill operations within the western, central, and eastern sections of site within Q2 of 2022, in line with our planned operational strategy.
